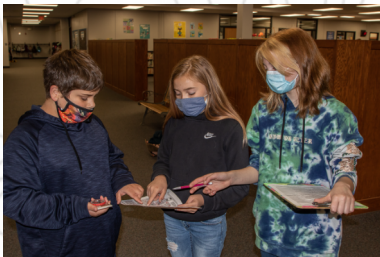
Team Navigation!™: is a unique methodology that combines the skills of Map & Compass Navigation from the international sport of Orienteering, with an interactive team process. Add a treasure chest & word puzzle, you have a fun-outdoor adventure that involves problem-solving, role-playing, experiential learning, communication, pushing comfort zones (but not panic zones!)

Navigation: the art & science of moving from one place to another, using a map & compass

Orienteering: international family sport of map & compass !! It uses topographic maps, Orienteering Flags, Clue Sheets, Punch Cards

...a 2 day preparation for the Field Trip...

Day 1: Navigating INSIDE School Building



- Inside School Map
- Introduce Symbols, Legends, Compass Rose
- Introduce Compass, Clue Sheets, Checkpoints
- Teams of 3-4
- No Running, Must Stay Together
- Rotating Roles

Day 2: Navigating OUTSIDE School Building



- Outside School Map
- Introduce Clue Sheets, Punch Cards, Word Puzzle
- Introduce dressing for weather as factor
- Same Teams, Roles
- No Running, Must Stay Together
- Treasure Chest at End

Day 3: Field Trip to Eagle Creek Park



- Color Topographic Map
- Same methodology, but IN THE WOODS..!!
- 1 Chaperone Per Team
- Students Become Teachers to Chaperones
- Chaperones Can't Direct, Only Follow..!!
- Treasure Chest at End

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
